Venue facilities

Café:	Open till 4.30 for hot and cold food and beverages.
Merchandise:	Fine Designs Sportswear / DE Photography
Warm-up gym	For accredited coaches and gymnasts only. Gymnasts should not consume food or drink (except water) in the warm-up gym, it is against the venue rules and to protect children with allergies
Changing rooms:	Hair should be dressed in changing rooms. No hair spray in the warm-up gym.

Gymnast Information

Gymnast's hand over / registration	Parents will hand their children over to the coaches at the Warm up Gym door. The coaches will register the gymnasts
Gymnast supervision:	Gymnasts will be under the supervision of their coaches for the duration of the event
Storage of personal belongings:	Gymnasts should bring a small bag to store their belongings and clothing. Expensive jewellery or electronic equipment should not be brought to the venue
Provisions / refreshments:	Gymnasts should bring a bottle of water. The event is ½ day so food should not be necessary, but should only be consumed in the café, if required
Hair / jewellery:	Jewellery is not allowed. Hair must be dressed (preferably) prior to attendance at the venue, or dressed in the changing rooms. Hair spray must not be used in the warm-up gym.
Gymnasts Seating:	Gymnasts will sit in the specified seating with their club. Gymnasts will not be allowed in the spectators seating area
Gymnasts attire:	Gymnasts should wear their club tracksuit for warm-up, march- on and presentations
Bandaging:	Bandaging should be flesh coloured
Competition times:	Timetables are subject to change. Gymnasts should be ready to compete up to 30 minutes before their allotted time
Medical /First Aid Provision:	Medical provision for the assessment and/or treatment of injuries sustained on the day will be available by qualified practitioners. Coaches should also have first aid kits with them. If injuries are serious an ambulance will be called. All injuries will be logged with BG.
Welfare Officer:	The Regional Welfare Officer will be available for the duration of the event and may be contacted via the event organiser
Presentations:	Gymnasts must attend the presentations with their club. They must wear their club tracksuit
Club photographs:	After the presentations, each club will be invited to the podium, starting with Heathrow, for group photographs.
Gymnast Dismissal:	Following group photographs each club will leave the arena with their coaches to prepare for leaving the venue, starting with Heathrow. All rubbish must be cleared away into the bins provided, and
	plastic taken home for recycling. The coaches will hand over the gymnasts to their parents/guardians at the warm-up gym door.
Spectator dismissal:	The Spectators will be invited to collect their gymnasts from the warm-up gym, in club order, starting with Heathrow. The coaches will hand-over the gymnasts to their parents

	/guardians at the warm-up gym door. Parents are asked not to delay the coaches at the end of the event and to clear the building as quickly as possible
Host venue	Gymnasts must respect and follow the rules of the host venue

Programmes:	Programmes will be sent to the clubs, and will appear on the BG website for individual printing, rather than printing and selling at the venue.
Final Scores:	The final scores will be uploaded to the event page on the LG website, within 3 days of the competition
Additional:	Parents should not approach the officials or judges. Any concerns should be raised with your club coaches

Coach qualifications:	Level 2 or above, require current gold BG membership, DBS, SPCA, a minimum level 2 qualification. Level 1 coaches require current silver BG membership, DBS, SPCA & minimum level 1 coach qualification.
Grades and levels in competition	Morning event: Grade 1, Grade 2, Grade 5, 11-16, Youth Afternoon event: Grade 3 &4: IDP: 12-18: 13-19: Senior
Medals and trophies	Gold, Silver and Bronze Medals will be awarded at Grades 1 – 5, Youth, IDP, and Disability Grades 1-3, 11-16, 12-18, 13-19, Senior
Tie Breaks	For first position, both partnerships will receive regional medals, but the partnership progressing to the NDP final will be decided by the FIG tie-break system

Progression to NDP final	The Gold medal partnerships from Grades 1-5, Youth, & IDP will progress to the NDP National finals. Disability Gold and Silver medallists from Grades 1, 2 & 3 will progress to the NDP National Disability finals. The gymnasts will compete as the 'London Team'- not under their club name. The gymnasts and coaches competing in the final will wear the LG kit. The LG ATC will pay the entry fees for the gymnasts to enter the final
NDP team competition	The London team at the NDP Team Competition will consist of 5 Partnerships selected by the TC from any category or any grade and include at least 1 x pair and 1 x group The winning region will be presented with the BG Regional Team Cup
Inter-Regional event:	The Silver medallists may progress to the Southampton Inter-Regional Competition at selected grades. The gymnasts will compete as the 'London Team'- not under their club name. The gymnasts and coaches competing in the Inter-Regional Competition will wear the LG kit.
Inter-regional team competition	The London team at the Inter-Regional Team Competition will consist of 5 Partnerships selected by the TC from any category or any grade and include of at least 1 x pair and 1 x group. The top 3 scores will count towards the winning score
LG Team Kit:	To save having the expense of purchasing the LG kit, the coaches have agreed that we should borrow from each other for the NDP final and the Southampton Inter-Regional Competition. When we know the sizes that are required, we will contact all the clubs for offers of kit loan. We welcome your co-operation in this matter.
